



World Archery's Beat the Outbreak target – week 10. It's very simple. Really...

You're going to shoot 10 arrows in five ends of two at a distance of up to 5, 8, 10 or 18 metres – and your score is the total of what you hit.

Each circle can only be scored once. (Cross them out once hit.) After being used, the circle becomes white space for scoring future ends (not current ends).

In case of a linecutter where the arrow hits one circle and white space, you receive the value of the circle.

In case of a linecutter where the arrow hits multiple circles, you receive the value of the lowest circle.

The highest score is 50. The lowest score is -20.

The goal is to score **0**.
